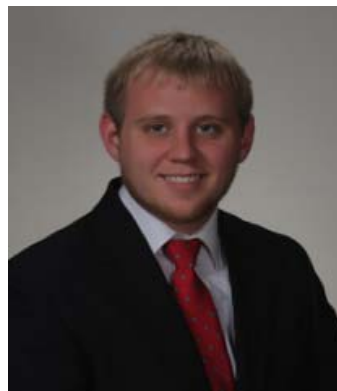
This year fellow brother Spencer McCormack played his guitar and song for his talent. At the end of the competition it was announced that he placed 2<sup>nd</sup>.

all the other nominees in the homecoming parade and also he gets an award.

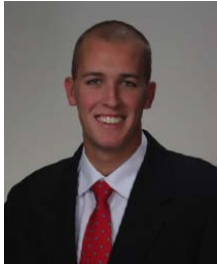


This year fellow brother Jared Hendricks was nominated for the award. He has done spectacular things to improve the Missouri Zeta chapter of Sigma Phi Epsi-

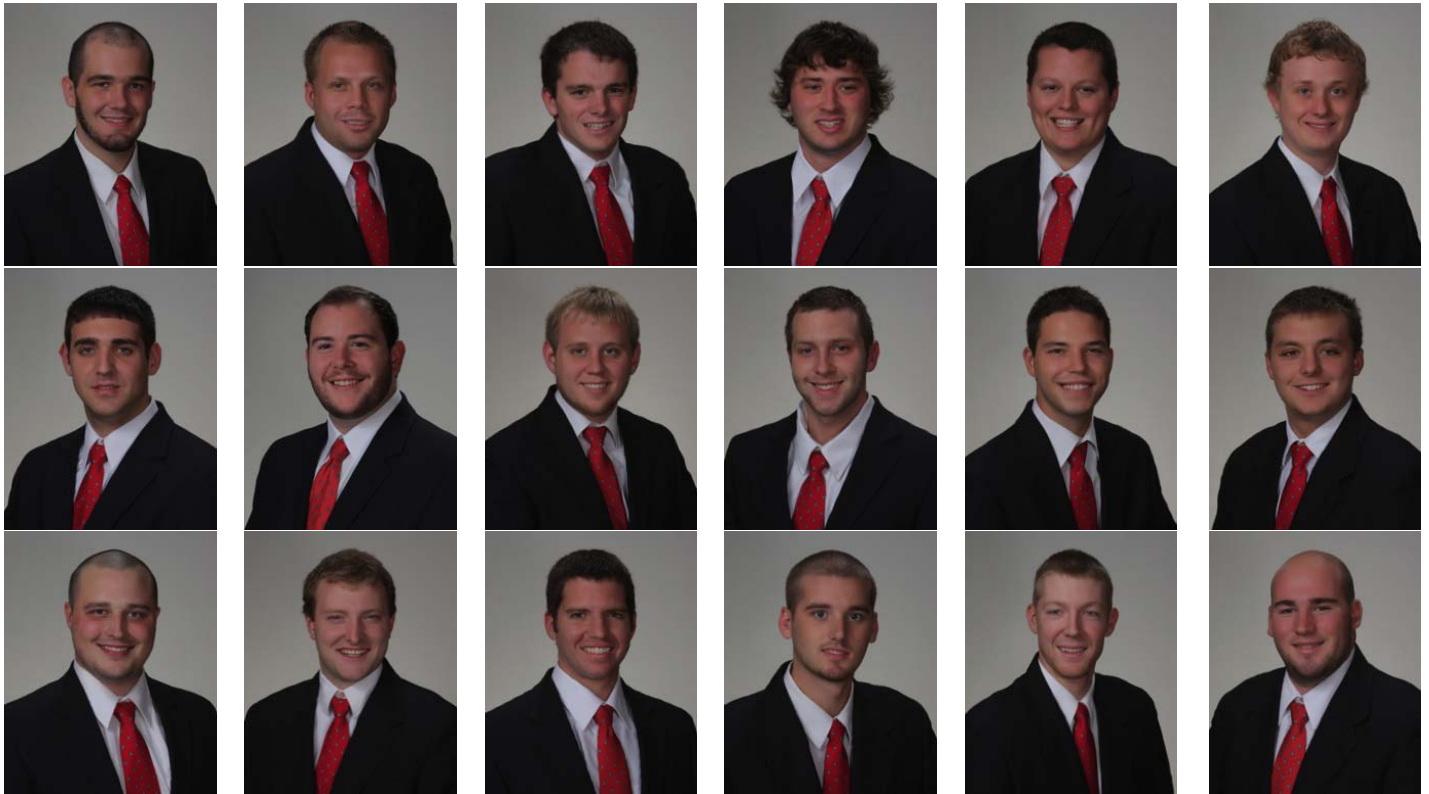
